We want you to use your skills and experience to support the school, enabling it to achieve its aims. You will be involved in creating a strategic framework for the school which will set aims and objectives. This framework will then be used to evaluate progress and outcomes throughout the year. Your role will include collectively allocating and controlling the school budget as well as appointing senior staff.

This is an extremely rewarding role, one which holds great importance within our school and trust.
